

GDPR Data Protection Policy for Tandem Property Asset Management

Introduction

Tandem Property Asset Management is committed to ensuring the privacy and security of personal data it processes. This policy outlines how we handle personal data in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which applies to all individuals within the European Union (EU) and the European Economic Area (EEA). The GDPR is designed to give individuals more control over their personal data and ensure organizations handle it responsibly.

1. Purpose of Data Processing

Tandem Property Asset Management processes personal data for various business purposes, including but not limited to:

- **Legitimate interests**: Where processing is necessary for our legitimate interests, provided these do not override the interests or rights of the individual.

4. Data Retention Period

We will retain personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, or as required by law. Once the data is no longer required, we will securely delete or anonymize it.

5. Data Sharing

We may share personal data with third parties in the following circumstances:

- **Service providers**: We may share data with third-party service providers (e.g., contractors, accountants, legal advisors) to assist in property management, financial management, or legal compliance.
- **Regulatory bodies**: We may disclose personal data to regulatory authorities, tax authorities, or other governmental bodies when required by law.
- Business transfers: In the event of a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, personal data may be transferred to the new owner, provided appropriate safeguards are in place.

6. Data Security

Tandem Property Asset Management implements appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the security of personal data, including protection against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction. These measures include encryption, firewalls, secure access protocols, and regular security audits.

7. Data Subject Rights

Under the GDPR, individuals have certain rights regarding their personal data. These rights include:
